BAPTISM:

Arrangements must be made at the Rectory. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. Parents, and also godparents when possible, must attend the Pre-Baptismal conference which is held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:30pm in the rectory.

CONFESSIONS:

Saturday afternoons 4:30 to 5:15 pm, and anytime at the Rectory.

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance at the rectory to ensure the date and the hour desired. The Nuptial Mass is the ordinary form of celebrating Christian marriage, and should be strongly considered when making Wedding plans. Attendance at the Pre-Cana Conferences, or the equivalent, is required by the Archbishop.

PARISH BOUNDARIES:

Central Park West to the Hudson River, from the South side of 77th Street down to the North side of 65th Street.

NEW PARISHIONERS:

We welcome new parishioners, and invite them to register at the Rectory. The registration is our only means of certifying anyone as a member of our parish. If you move to another Parish, or change your address within the Parish, please notify us.

FATIMA DEVOTIONS:

The Rosary is said daily after the 12:10 pm Mass. Friday from 6-7 pm there is a holy hour.

BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:

First Friday - Exposition: 12:35 pm.
Adoration: All day; Benediction: 5:15 PM.

MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA:

Mondays, before the 12:10 Mass and before the 5:30 pm Mass.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS:

Classes in Religion for Catholic children/teenagers, Pre-kindergarten - High School take place on Sundays. The Family Mass begins at 10:00 a.m. in the Church followed by class instruction in the school.

Ongoing religious education is important for the religious development of your children. First Communion and Confirmation require a two year program.

PARISH NEWS

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This week, on Tuesday the 25th of July, we celebrate the 32nd anniversary of the death of Father Edward McKaharay, a boy of this parish, who returned as the pastor. He died all too early, please remember him in your prayer.

I must say, your prayer is truly effective! Remember all my laments last week, and my request that you pray that the tabernacle would be restored.....and that the Building Department would finally come to inspect and approve the new chair lift? Well on Monday morning the tabernacle WAS restored.....and on Tuesday, the Buildings Department Official arrived, conducted the inspection, and approved the lift! Keep those prayers coming.....and thank you!

Tuesday is the Feast of St. James the Apostle. He is called “the Greater” because he followed Jesus before the other disciple with the same name, James the Less, whose feast we celebrate on May 3rd (The Feast of Philip and James).

While summertime is often quiet at the parish, this summer various members of the Pastoral Planning Committee continue to meet, implementing some of the many wonderful ideas to come out of the parish survey. These words from Pope Francis’ homily at the Cathedral of St. Peter & Paul in Philadelphia remind me of all that is happening here these days.

“One of the great challenges facing the Church in this generation is to foster in all the faithful a sense of personal responsibility for the Church’s mission, and to enable them to fulfill that responsibility as missionary disciples, as a leaven of the Gospel in our world. This will require creativity in adapting to changed situations, carrying forward the legacy of the past not primarily by maintaining our structures and institutions, which have served us well, but above all by being open to the possibilities which the Spirit opens up to us and communicating the joy of the Gospel, daily and in every season of our life.

We know that the future of the Church in a rapidly changing society will call, and even now calls, for a much more active engagement on the part of the laity. The Church in the United States has always devoted immense effort to the work of catechesis and education. Our challenge today is to build on those solid foundations and to foster a sense of collaboration and shared responsibility in planning for the future of our parishes and institutions. This does not mean relinquishing the spiritual authority with which we have been entrusted; rather, it means discerning and employing wisely the manifold gifts which the Spirit pours out upon the Church. In a particular way, it means valuing the immense contribution which women, lay and religious, have made and continue to make, to the life of our communities.”

I hope you might consider some way in which you can better enrich the parish community.....please pray about it, and please pray for peace.

El martes día 25 de julio conmemoramos el fallecimiento del Sacerdote Edward McKaharay, criado en este vecindario y quien luego volvió llegando a ser nuestro Pastor. Murió muy joven y les pido rezar por el.

Debo admitir que las plegarias son realmente efectivas! Recuerdan que les pedí la semana pasada rezar por que el tabernáculo fuera restaurado...y que el Departamento de Edificios finalmente viniera a inspeccionar el "HandiLift"? Pues el lunes por la mañana el Tabernáculo fue restaurado, y el martes llego un oficial del Departamento de Edificios, condujo la inspección y ya podemos usar el "HandLift".

El martes celebramos la Fiesta del Apóstol Santiago. Se le llama "el Mas Grande" pues siguió a Jesus antes que otro discípulo de igual nombre, Santiago el Menor, y cuya fiesta se celebra el 3 de mayo (Fiesta de Santos Felipe y Santiago).

A pesar que el verano es muy tranquilo en nuestra parroquia, esta vez varios miembros del Comité de Planeamiento Pastoral continua reuniéndose e implementando varias de las ideas recopiladas en el survey. Las siguientes palabras del sermón del Papa Francisco en la Catedral de San Pedro Y San Pablo en Filadelfia me recuerdan lo que aquí sucede en estos días:

"Uno de los grandes retos a los que se enfrenta la Iglesia en esta generación es fomentar en todos los fieles un sentido de responsabilidad personal por la misión de la Iglesia y hacer que cumplan esa responsabilidad como discípulos misioneros, como levadura del Evangelio en nuestro mundo . Esto requerirá creatividad para adaptarse a las situaciones cambiadas, llevando adelante el legado del pasado no principalmente manteniendo nuestras estructuras e instituciones que nos han servido bien, pero sobre todo abriéndose a las posibilidades que el Espíritu nos abre y nos comunica la alegría del Evangelio, todos los días y en cada época de nuestra vida.

Sabemos que el futuro de la Iglesia en una sociedad que cambia rápidamente llamará, e incluso ahora llama, a un compromiso mucho más activo por parte de los laicos. La Iglesia en los Estados Unidos siempre ha dedicado un inmenso esfuerzo a la catequesis y a la educación. Nuestro desafío hoy es construir sobre esos sólidos cimientos y fomentar un sentido de colaboración y responsabilidad compartida en la planificación para el futuro de nuestras parroquias e instituciones. Esto no significa renunciar a la autoridad espiritual con la que se nos ha confiado; Más bien, significa discernir y emplear sabiamente los múltiples dones que el Espíritu derrama sobre la Iglesia. En particular, significa valorar la inmensa contribución que la mujer, laica y religiosa ha hecho y continúa haciendo, a la vida de nuestras comunidades ".

Espero que usted considere alguna manera en la cual pueda enriquecer mejor la comunidad parroquial por favor ore por ella, y por favor ore por la paz.
